<i>Acer cissifolium</i>	Japanese vineleaf Maple	6-10m						Image to come	Broadly columnar. Multiple autumn colour, deciduous.
<i>Acer davidii</i>	Snake bark Maple	10m+						Image to come	Interesting feature of bark during the winter months. Deciduous.
<i>Acer henryi</i>	Henry's Maple	6-10m						Image to come	Broadly columnar, deciduous. New leaves pinkish with 3 leaflets.
<i>Acer japonicum</i>	Fullmoon Maple	3-6 m						Image to come	Broadly spreading, deciduous. Purple-red flowers before the leaves.
<i>Acer japonicum</i> <i>aconitifolium</i>	Lace leaf fullmoon Maple	3-6 m						Image to come	Broadly spreading, deciduous.
<i>Acer palmatum</i> 'Senkaki'	Maple	3-6m						Image to come	Striking red stems and twigs after leaf fall.
<i>Acer platanoides</i> <i>v. palmatifidum</i>	Norway maple	5-10 m						Image to come	Broadly spreading, deciduous. Small tree.
<i>Acer Red Palmatum</i> 'Emperor'	Maple	6-10m							Broadly columnar, deciduous. Brilliant red colour.
<i>Acer rubrum</i>	American Maple	12m+						Image to come	Red foliage, columnar habit, deciduous.
<i>Acer Palmatum</i> 'Shindishojo'	Japanese Maple	2-4m							Red spring foliage, deciduous.
<i>Acer sieboldianum</i>	Siebolds Maple	3-8m						Image to come	Erect growing small deciduous tree. Suits small spaces, very cold hardy, prefers moist sites.
<i>Acer triflorum</i>	Three flowered Maple	5-10m						Image to come	Broadly spreading, deciduous. Grey-brown bark peeling vertically. Small yellow flowers in spring.
<i>Aesculus carnea</i> <i>briottii</i>	Ruby Red Horsechestnut	15m+							Recommended for streets due to the prickly seedpods being nearly absent on this cultivar. Deciduous.
<i>Carpinus betulus</i> 'Fastigata'	Upright Hornbeam	10m						Image to come	Upright form. Proven species for streets, very hardy. Deciduous.

<i>Corylopsis griffithii</i>	Himalayan winterhazel	2-4m							Broadly upright and deciduous. New leaves purplish, creamy yellow flowers in Spring .
<i>Ginkgo biloba 'Fastigiata' (Male Only)</i>	Ginkgo	15m+							Upright form, deciduous. Yellow foliage in spring.
<i>Lagerstroemia indica</i>	Crepe Myrtle	4-6m							Bark and flower display, deciduous.
<i>Liriodendron chinensis</i>	Chinese tulip	15m+							Broadly columnar, large tree, deciduous.
<i>Liriodendron Chinensis 'Fastigiata'</i>	Chinese tulip	15m+							Compact upright form. Large tree, deciduous.
<i>Magnolia Stellata and varieties</i>	Star Magnolia	10m+							Late winter/early spring flowering, deciduous.
<i>Magnolia doltsolpa</i>	Sweet Michelia	10m							Flowering, mostly evergreen.
<i>Magnolia doltsolpa 'lemon fragrant'</i>	Sweet Michelia	10m							Flowering. Fragrant, mostly evergreen.
<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Tupelo	8-10m							Hardy tree for wet sites. Brilliant red autumn colour, deciduous.
<i>Olea europaea</i>	Olive	6-8m							Relatively compact, takes pruning well, mostly evergreen.
<i>Parrotia persica</i>	Persian iron-wood	6-8m							Hardy, interesting bark features and structure, deciduous.
<i>Prunus Yedoensis 'Awanui'</i>	Flowering Cherry	6-10m							Spring flowering, bird attractant, deciduous.
<i>Prunus Shimidsu sakura</i>	Asahi Boton Cherry	6-10m							Spring flowering, bird attractant, deciduous.
<i>Quercus cercis</i>	Turkey Oak	15m+							Character areas, large tree, deciduous.

<i>Nestegis cunninghamii</i>	Black Maire	15+						Image to come	Slow growing hardy, large specimen tree. Evergreen.
<i>Nestegis lanceolata</i>	White Maire	10m+						Image to come	Handsome tree with narrow leaves, evergreen.
<i>Nothofagus fusca</i>	Red Beech	15m+							Hardy, Interesting form, layered branchlets, evergreen.
<i>Nothofagus solandri</i>	Black Beech	15m+						Image to come	Long lived hardy tree, minimal leaf drop, evergreen.
<i>Pennantia corymbosa</i>	Kaikomako	6-10m						Image to come	Masses of white flowers, bird attractant, gully links, divercating form when juvenile, evergreen.
<i>Podocarpus totara</i>	Totara	15m+							Large tree, long lived, food source for birds, evergreen.
<i>Sophora microphylla</i>	Kowhai	6-10m							Flowers , gully links , bird attractant, mostly evergreen.
<i>Weinmannia racemosa</i>	Kamahi	6 - 10m							Hardy, massess of flowers, evergreen.
<i>Vitex lucens</i>	Puriri	15m+						Image to come	Native evergreen. Winter food for wood pigeons.
